Christmas Jumpers

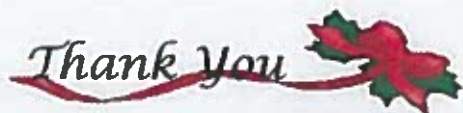
On Friday 20 December, the Charity Group are fundraising for Cash for Kids. For a small donation, pupils can wear a Christmas jumper to school.
